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Transition Process

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Transition Process

- **Tonight's meeting**
- **Visits to Feeder Primary Schools by the Transition team**
Meet the members of the transition team, learn about the transition process and learn about 'Our School - Our King Alfred's'.
- **Specific meeting regarding students with SEN**
Miss Wilkins will meet with the Feeder Primary SENCOs to share information.
- **Enhanced Transition for Identified Students**
These will be students identified by our Feeder primaries. They will spend 5 sessions here at KAS working with the SEN team.

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Transition Process

- **Year 6/7 Lessons in English, Maths and Science.**
Big primaries - In the primary school.
East Huntspill, West Huntspill and Pawlett - Here at KAS on 12th June.
Pick up by minibus.
- **Transition Days - 9th, 10th and 11th July**
Will start with an assembly in Main Hall. Throughout the days students will experience Tutor Times, subject specific lessons and have lessons regarding expectations at The King Alfred School.
- **Parents meeting - 10th July**
- **Extra Transition Day - 13th July**
A small groups of students from most primary school will be notified if they are involved.

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Uniform

- Shirts, school tie and school blazer. Shirts must be tucked in.
- Trousers– Regular or skinny plain black in standard full length cut. Jeans and leggings or other similar trousers are not permitted.
- Skirts – Skirts should be A-line or straight, plain black and of an appropriate length which ensures that they do not lie more than 5 centimetres above or below the knee. Split skirts are not permitted. Plain black tights are encouraged with a skirt.
- Jumpers (optional) – Black V neck.
- Shoes – Shoes must be plain black, closed toe school shoes with no studs or metal. Trainers, boots, backless shoes, canvas or ‘plimsoll’ type shoes including Converse and Vans, are not permitted.
- Coats – Coats must be sensible, showerproof and appropriate for school. Hoodies and denim jackets/coats are not permitted.

- Most of the other subjects will set homework fortnightly

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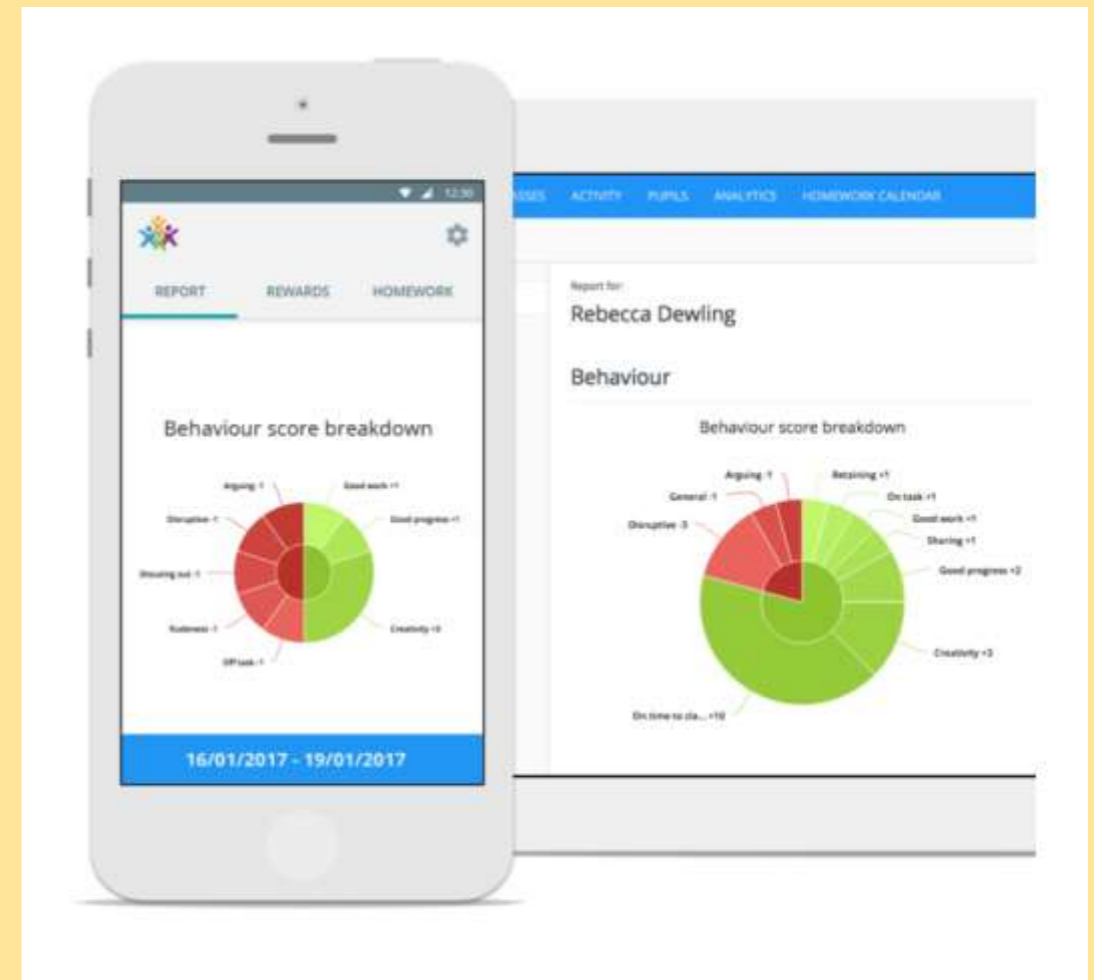


Class Charts

You can view Class Charts online or you can download the Class Charts app to your phone or tablet.

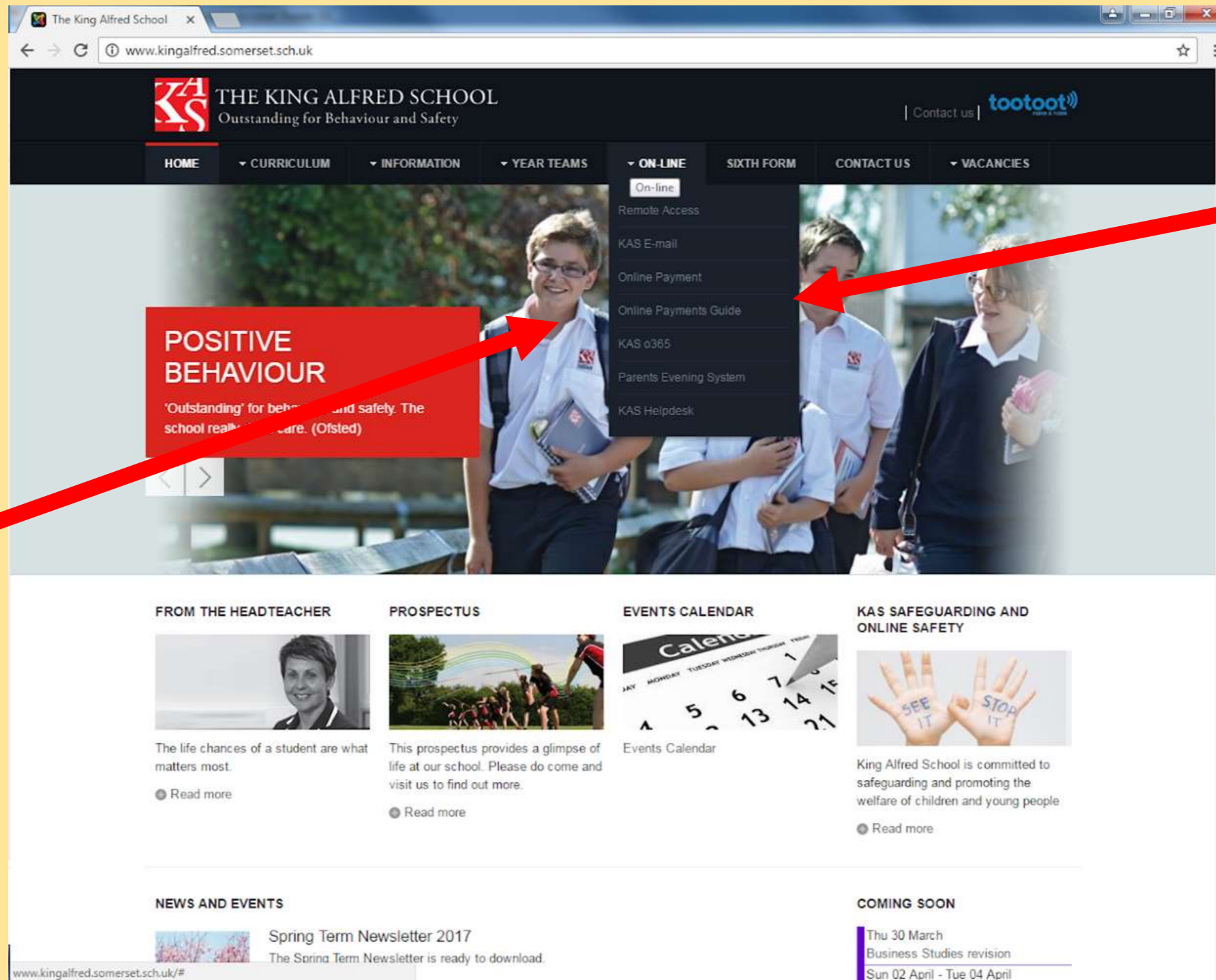
On Class Charts you can see:
